- Ultimately, which of these people will be remembered most? Why?

Read: Matthew 27:27-44

- 1. Why were the soldiers so cruel in this case? What does that say about their view of Jesus? Of themselves?
- 2. Why does Jesus need Simon's help? What shape is Jesus in?
- 3. For what "official" reason is Jesus crucified (v. 37)?
- 4. What three groups taunt Jesus? Why these particular insults?
- 5. How is this scene like a mock coronation? What did Jesus actually deserve?

Heart Questions

- 1. If Jesus came today, who would "crucify him"? What would be the charge against him? Where would you be?
- 2. In what way does the agony of these insults deepen your appreciation of what Christ did for you in his death?
- 3. How have you made Jesus King in your life?
- 4. What words can you use to express your feelings to Jesus about his crucifixion?
- 5. How can this group pray for you?
